

## **RADWINTER ROAD CEMETERY, SAFFRON WALDEN – BROKEN HEADSTONES AND KERB SETS**

The Town Council is carrying out Health and Safety inspections to the headstones and kerb sets in Radwinter Road Cemetery, Saffron Walden. As part of that work, Cemetery operatives are shortly to carry out renovations in Compartments 40, 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45. These are the older compartments to the East behind the stone shed where burials typically took place from 1929 – 1968. Some graves have loose headstones and it is the Council's intention to make them safe by laying them down.
